### **Resurrections in history**

There are 2 categories of resurrections in history ...

"The First Resurrection" of all saved

- 1. Jesus Christ I Corinthians 15:20-23
- 2. Selected Old Testament Saints Matthew 27:51-54
- 3. Rapture of the Church Saints I Thessalonians 4:13-18
- 4. Tribulation Martyrs Revelation 20:4-6
- 5. Old Testament Saints Daniel 12:1-2

"The Second Resurrection" of all unsaved (the lost)

1. Wicked of all generations – Revelation 20:11-15

# Pre-trib, mid-trib or post-trib

**Doctrine of the Pre-Tribulation Rapture** – Jesus is coming to take His Church home *BEFORE* the Tribulation – this is based on literal interpretation of Scripture ...

- 1. Taking the Bible as it's written literally!
- 2. Bible verses that promise deliverance "ek" kept from, not through the wrath to come I Thessalonians 1:10, Revelation 3:10, I Thessalonians 5:9
- 3. The Church has nothing to do with the purpose of the Tribulation; it's Israel Daniel 9:24-27
- 4. The Church is never mentioned in the Tribulation chapters of Revelation!
- 5. The Rapture is called the "Blessed Hope" Hope = 3 ½ years of hell first as a requirement?
- 6. Goes with the natural flow and order of Revelation AND ALL of Scripture!
- 7. The Rapture and Second Coming are distinguished in Scripture Rapture = Jesus coming to save believers, Second Coming = Jesus coming to judge the people on the earth

Doctrine of the Mid-Tribulation Rapture – Jesus is coming *DURING* the Tribulation – this is assumed from Matthew 24:22 "elect", I Thessalonians 1:10 "seal & trumpet judgments" are not wrath?, 2 witnesses "symbolic of the Church being resurrected after the Antichrist kills them" in Revelation 11

Doctrine of the Post-Tribulation Rapture – Jesus is coming to 'rapture' the Church *AFTER* the Tribulation period & then bring us back down immediately for the Second Coming. This view is derived from Jesus & John both using the word 'tribulation' (same as the Greek word used for the actual Tribulation). Was the Tribulation around during Jesus' earthly ministry? "Context is king!" also, believed as a result of "The First Resurrection" mentioned in Revelation 20 "did not mean first in time, but rather first in kind." – John Walvoord ... Lastly, we need witnesses to save the lost during the Tribulation AND it will help us to grow in sanctification ... They have the 2 Witnesses, the 144,000 Jewish Evangelists, Flying Eagles proclaiming the Gospel ... Christ's death is enough to sanctify us!

The Doctrine of *Imminence* What about a '*partial rapture*'?

#### "The Rapture of the Church – part II"

#### **Rapture vs. Second Coming**

Rapture = Coming of the Lord Jesus Christ in the clouds to gather His people to go home before the Tribulation period begins. This will be a bodily resurrection of the Church Age believers (AD.33 - ?) and could occur anytime without the necessity of signs. In other words, it's imminent – Revelation 22:20! Second Coming = Second part of Jesus' return to judge the people of the earth. This will occur after the Tribulation period is complete. This return is preceded by many signs – Matthew 24:29-31!

#### **RAPTURE VS SECOND COMING**

- 1. R = Jesus comes into the air for His own///SC = Jesus comes with His own to the earth
- 2. R = Church taken into heaven///SC = Kingdom set up on earth
- 3. R = could happen at any time///SC= will happen at the end of the Tribulation period
- 4. R = no signs accompany it///SC = many signs accompany it
- 5. R= for believers only///SC = affects all humanity
- 6. R = time of joy///SC = time of mourning
- 7. R = no mention of Satan///SC = Satan is bound for 1,000 years
- 8. R = Judgment Seat of Christ follows///SC = Millennium follows
- 9. R = only His own will see Him///SC = everyone will see Him
- **10.** R = leaving to get married///SC = returning as the Bride of Christ (wedding reception)

#### The Stages of the Rapture

- 1. Jesus will descend from His Father's house John 14:1-3, I Thess. 4:16
- 2. He will resurrect deceased believers in Christ I Thess. 4:14-15, I Cor. 15:51-52
- 3. This will occur in the 'twinkling of an eye' I Cor. 15:52
- 4. The trumpet call of God will sound to summons us I Thess. 4:16, I Cor. 15:52, Rev. 4:1
- 5. We who are alive will join the 'dead in Christ' in the air I Thess. 4:17, I Cor. 15:51, 53
- 6. We will all get new, glorified bodies I Cor. 15:52-55
- 7. We will meet in the clouds & be with the Lord FOREVER I Thess. 4:17
