9. According to Matthew 13:20-21 some people hear the Gospel but have no root. They last for a short while and when trouble comes they <u>-</u> (Superficial)
10. According to Matthew 13:22, the Gospel message can be off. (Stifled)
11. According to Mathew 13:23, the Gospel can take root and fruit. (Solid)
12. One day we will all stand before God and give an (2 Corinthians 5:10 & Romans 14:12).
